

# BUSHRANGER SAND FLAG

Anyone familiar with desert or sand travel would be well aware of the staple or go-to flag in Australia, the Bushranger three-piece design. It has been around for ages and has more than proven its value and reliability. But the flag has just been given an update, one we are pretty impressed with. Gone is the push-lock type of mount, and in is a new quick-release base, secured with a tractor pin.

The new mounting adaptor makes it incredibly easy to mount and remove the flag and has been designed to further improve the hardiness of the flag assembly in what is often salty and always sandy conditions.

We drove with the new design right around the coastal dunes of the Eyre Peninsula and the Googs Track recently. The flag was subjected to plenty of salt water, fine grit and at times mud. It was also driven into scores of overhanging hardwood branches – all without an issue. The new adaptor makes a great product even better now. It is a winner. **4x4**
